2011 Burbank City Amateur Golf Championship Regulations

Entry Fee

Entry fee is \$140. All net proceeds will be returned in form of pro shop credit or tee prizes.

Refund Policy

All refund requests must be made in writing to the Tournament Chairman. No refunds after October 14th, 2011. A \$25 service charge will be deducted.

Dress Code

Golfers must wear shirts with collars. Shorts are allowed, however, short shorts, tennis shorts, or bathing trunks are not allowed. Clothes must be clean and in good repair. Dress code will be enforced. Soft spikes are required.

Championship Flight (Gross Only)

The Championship Flight is an open flight (no age limit, men or women) conducted over 54 holes. The Championship Flight will be contested on the DeBell Golf Course. The field will be cut to the top 32 and ties after 36 holes, to play the final round on Sunday.

Championship entrants must have a verifiable low index as of 9/1/2011 of 4.1 or lower. A certification of your playing ability from your home course golf pro, instructor or coach is also acceptable. Please send verification with entry.

Class Flight (Net within Flights)

Open to all players 18 or older with a verifiable 12-month low index as of 9/1/2011 ranging from 4.2 to 22.6. **Entrants with higher indexes must play down to a 24 handicap.** The field will be divided into five flights to play over 36 holes on the DeBell Golf Course, slope 119. The flights will be broken down into the following:

	5 to 8	9 to 12	
13 to 16	17 to 20	21 to 24	

The tournament chairman reserves the right to adjust handicaps based on previous tournament play. All adjustments are final.

Ladies Flight

Open to all ladies 18 or older with a 12-month low index as of 9/1/2011 ranging from 4.5 to 26.0. **Entrants with higher indexes must play down to a 28 handicap.** Flights will be determined based on entries received. An insufficient number of entries will result in one general ladies flight with a Gross & Net Flight. Handicaps will be based on a slope of 115.

The tournament chairman reserves the right to adjust handicaps based on previous tournament play. All adjustments are final.
